- Pasco Parks update
  - o Park will be opening 2019, not 2018

- A pet grooming salon in Kennewick off 395 and Vista
- Pooch Plunge Planning is almost complete
  - Waiting to hear back from a few vendors
  - \$5 to get in, per dog each day

## City Of Richland Parks Department Joe Schiessl and Jason Janosky:

- Maintenance crews. Communications regarding mow day and turf damages has not improved
  - Suggested that we could do a weekly walkthrough, have used flags in the past to show where holes are
  - We are willing to fill the holes with buckets if provided dirt- the city will need to re-look into our adopt-a-park agreement and there may need to be insurance
  - Suggested to paint a white circle around the manhole in the 2nd phase
  - Small dog park users are filling holes with rocks
  - Suggested a sandbox for dogs to dig by a member
  - Suggested to have a family-friendly park for kids by a member
- Concrete pad drains causing some big issues
- Gazebo area is looking bad. Repairs needed
- Still needing chains and an open padlock
- New rules have many park users upset. Park etiquette suggestions

## **Top Complaints:**

- 1. Rules are not enforced
- 2. Children in the park
- 3. Losing the shy dog area
- 4. Park closing time vs watering times clashes Sprinklers start at 9 and run 8 hours
